



Frequently Asked Questions for European Training Programme (ETP) 2023

Who can apply for ETP?

In order to apply to be a delegate for the ETP the following criteria for individuals must be fulfilled:

1. Geography

Delegates are welcomed from those working in the European countries listed below. Please note that delegates from or working in countries that are or become subject to EU/UK/International Sanctions will not be eligible to apply.

2. Organisation

Applying delegates should be working or volunteering for Not for Profit (e.g., Non-Government Organisation or Charity or Community Based Organisation) that work to improve dog or dog and cat welfare.

Those organisations must be legally registered to operate in the country.

3. Delegates

Delegates can be in any role within an organisation, we welcome those who work directly with the animals or in fundraising or administrative roles and volunteers.

Delegates applying should have the permission of the head of the organisation to attend.

The ETP is conducted in English, therefore a good understanding of English is required by delegates.
